Great American Eclipse **e**

WED Apr 3 | 8p

Explore the spectacular cosmic phenomenon of a total solar eclipse. On April 8th, 2024, while the Pacific Northwest will experience only a partial eclipse, a total solar eclipse will cast the moon's shadow along a diagonal path from Texas up to Maine, plunging that region into darkness for over four minutes — nearly twice as long as the last American eclipse in 2017.

The Incomparable Mr. Buckley

American public intellectual, conservative author and commentator William F. Buckley fused traditional conservatism and classical liberalism, thereby laying the groundwork for the rightward shift in the Republican Party exemplified by Barry Goldwater and Ronald Reagan. Buckley founded the *National Review* and hosted *Firing Line* from 1966 to 1999. He was a journalist, novelist, politician, debater, orator, loving husband and father, but first and foremost he was a conversationalist and storyteller who profoundly changed America.
